The purpose of this document is to communicate LEAXs requirements with respect to suppliers of Non-Automotive Products and Services, Transports and Logistic Solutions.

1 Applicability

LEAX Groups European subsidiaries.

2 Requirements

2.1 General

Comply and follow the United Nations Global Compact's principles relating to labour practices, human rights, environment, and anti-corruption as well as LEAX Group Supplier Code of Conduct.

2.2 Transport and Logistic Solutions

Contracted Transport and Logistic Solutions companies should preferably be ISO 14001 certified, or have an environment policy, or an ongoing environmental work.

2.3 Non-Automotive Products (NAP) and Services

NAP are products not directly connected to the delivery of LEAX parts and services delivered to customer.

2.3.1 Electricity

As guideline fossil free energy should be sourced were available and commercially sustainable. Sourcing is mainly a site responsibility but could be managed centrally when and if needed.

Fossil free energy:

- Renewable Energy
 - Solar Energy
 - Wind Power
 - Hydropower
 - Geothermal Energy
 - Tidal Power
- Nuclear Power

2.3.2 Heating

As guideline heating should be sourced from renewable sources were available and commercially sustainable. Sourcing is a site responsibility.

2.3.3 Chemicals

All LEAX Suppliers shall comply with the EU Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) (EC) 1907/2006.

LEAX shall receive a Safety Data Sheet for all chemical products used in, or in connection with, any article when there is a risk that LEAX employees can be exposed to these chemical products. It is a site responsibility to secure access to the Safety Data Sheets needed.

2.3.4 Waste handling

All suppliers of waste handling shall have appropriate permits for its business. Compliance is a site responsibility.

2.3.5 Supplies

There are no defined environmental requirements on supplies and its suppliers. If there are local significant aspects affected by this commodity it is a local responsibility to address any specific requirements to the supplier.

2.3.6 Entrepreneurial services

There are no defined environmental requirements on entrepreneurial services and its suppliers. If there are local significant aspects affected by this commodity it is a local responsibility to address any specific requirements to the supplier.
